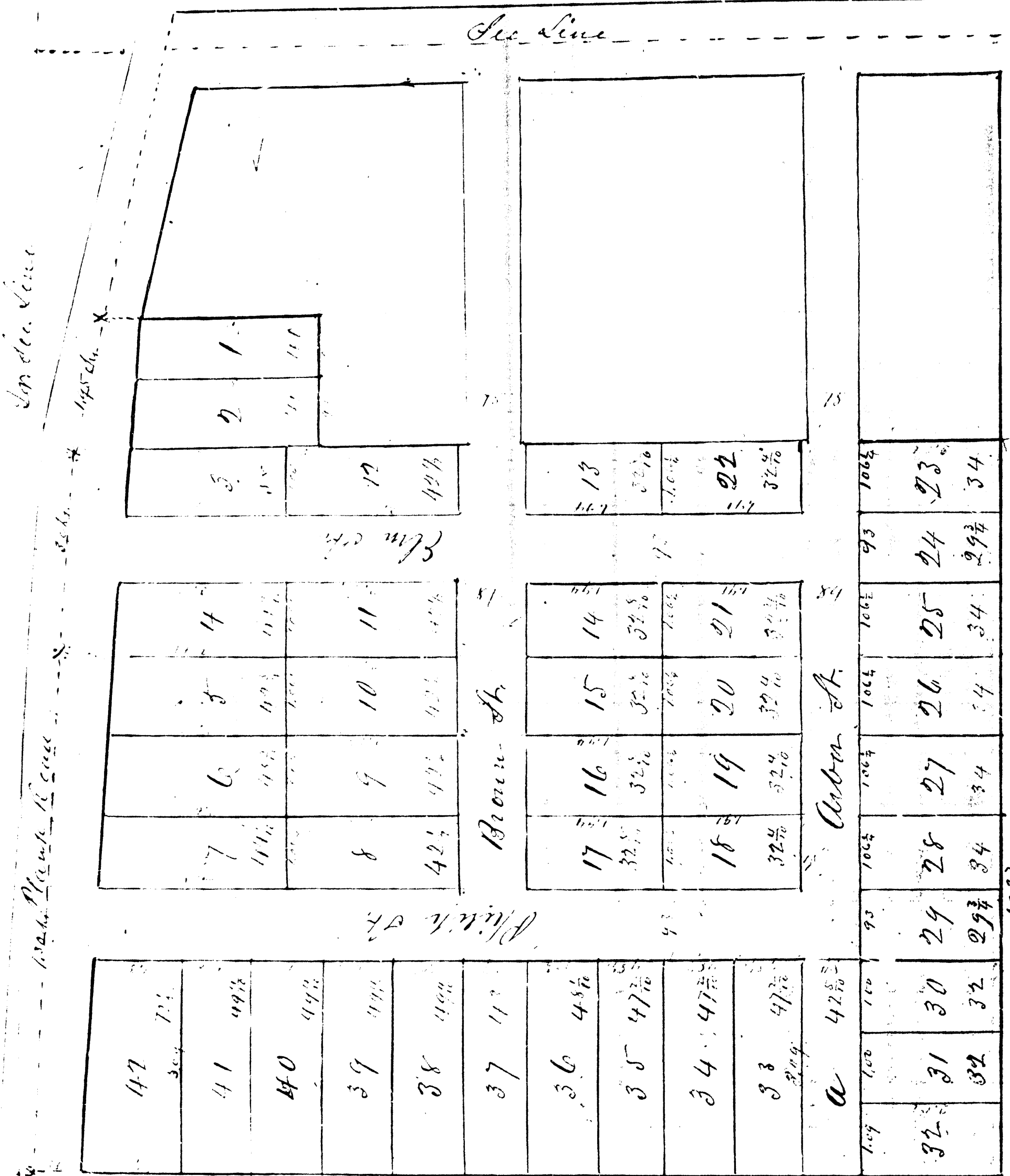


Brown & Bach's Addition to the City of Ann Arbor, Michigan

The lot on which this plat is located is described as follows, viz: Being all that certain tract or parcel of land situated in the Township of Ann Arbor, Wacktanaw County, and State of Michigan, known as the North west quarter of the North East quarter of section number Thirty-two, Township Two South, of Range Six East, excepting and reserving Twelve acres of land heretofore sold, and divided from the East side of the above description, also excepting six acres of land heretofore sold, and divided from the north side thereof, also excepting four and one half acres of land heretofore sold, and divided from the south side thereof being seventeen and one half acres, more or less.

I, a Notary Public, in and for said County, do hereby Wacktanaw County, this 15th day of June, A.
