Note, the lengths and breadth of the streets and lots are indicated on the plat in rods feet and inches.

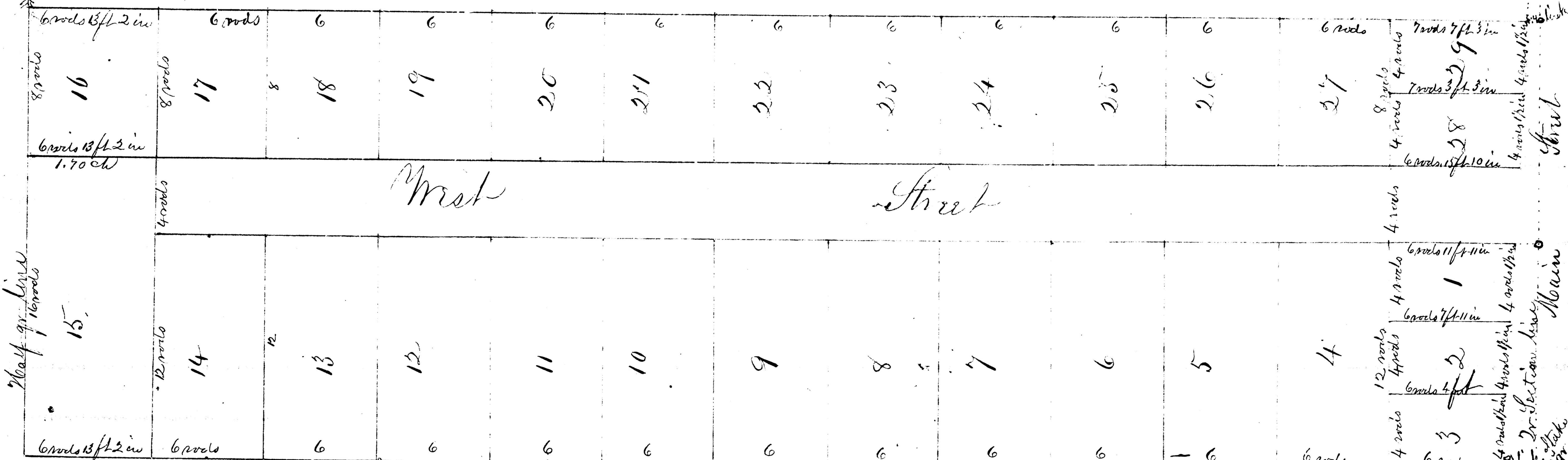
