

**DESCRIPTION**

The land embraced in the Eber White Addition to the City of Ann Arbor is a portion of the south east one quarter of section 30, Town 2 S., Range 6 E., described as follows: Beginning at the point (1) where the south line of West Liberty Street intersects the east line of said section 30; thence south along the east line of section 30 to a point (2) which is seven hundred twenty four (724) feet south of the said south line of West Liberty Street; thence west, at right angles to the said east line of section 30 to a point (3) seven hundred fourteen (714) feet west of the said east line of section 30; thence north, parallel to the said east line of section 30, to a point (4) three hundred forty five and eighty-three one hundredths (345.83) feet north of the last described southerly boundary of the plat; thence north 14° 32' 20" west a distance of one hundred eighty-six and eight one hundredths (186.08) feet to a point (5) on the south line of West Liberty Street; thence north 75° 28' 20" east along the said south line of West Liberty Street a distance of seven hundred eighty six (786) feet to the point of beginning. The City limits of the City of Ann Arbor pass thru the above described property in a straight line parallel to the south line of West Liberty Street and at a distance of one hundred ninety eight (198) feet measured parallel to the east line of section 30, south therefrom. That portion of this plat lying north of the City Limits is within the City of Ann Arbor, while that portion south of said City Limits is in the Township of Ann Arbor but not within the City of Ann Arbor.

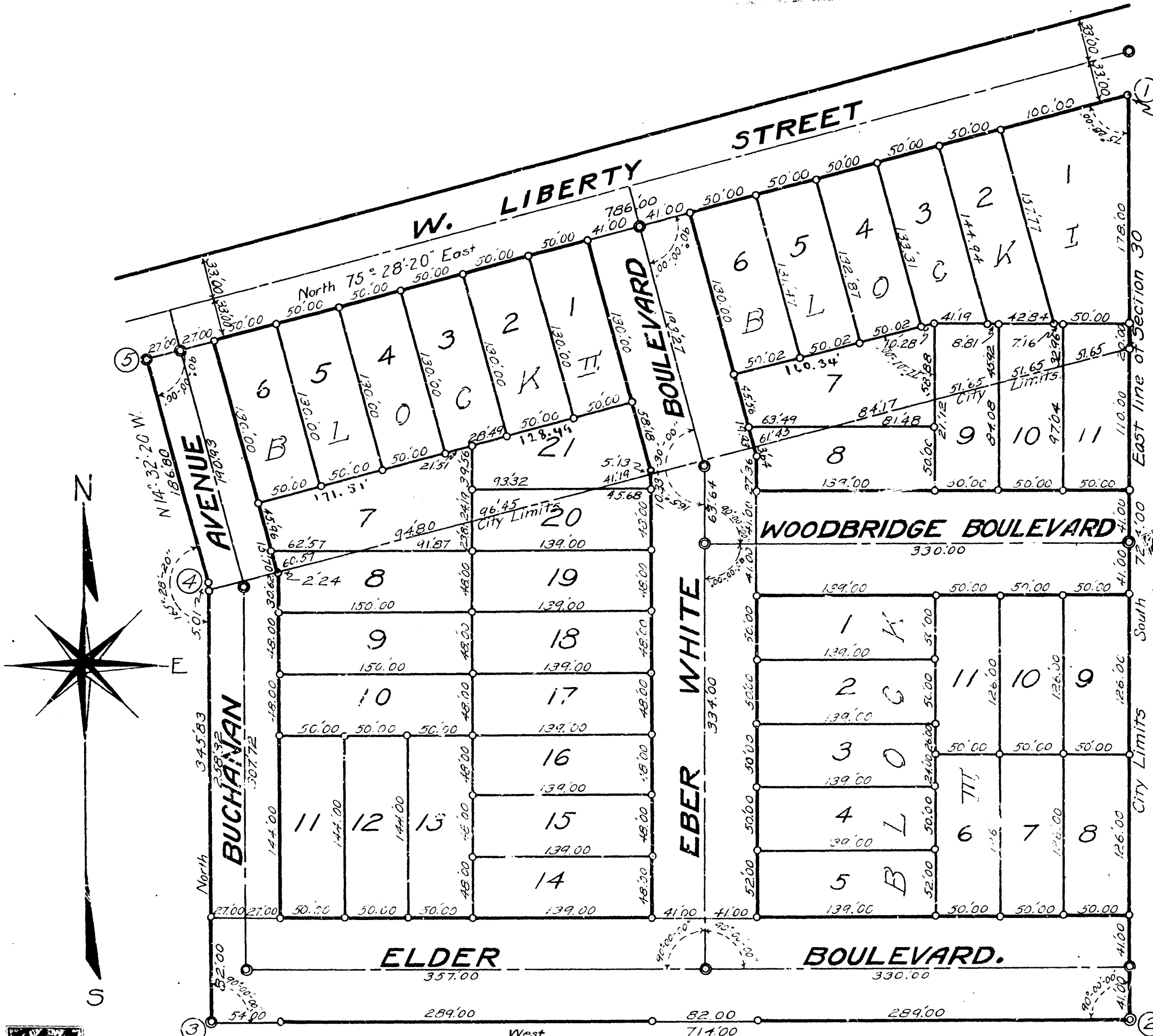
**SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:**
