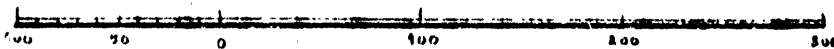


JOHN F. LAWRENCE'S ADDITION

TO THE
City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw Co.

The land embraced in the annexed plat of John F. Lawrence's Addition to the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw Co., Mich., is described as follows:— Beginning at a point on the East line of section 32, T. 2 S., R. 6 E., distant 355.94 ft. from the N.E. corner of said section 32, and point being at the intersection of the centre lines of State and Grove Sts., so called, in the City of Ann Arbor; thence South along the centre of State St., and on said East line of section 32, 299.06 ft.; thence West and parallel to the North line of said section 32, 132.28 ft. to the North line of said section 32; thence North along said 1/2 line 165 ft.; thence East, and parallel to the North line of section 32, 132 ft.; thence North and parallel to said 1/2 line, 66 ft., to the N. line of section 32; thence East on said N. line of section 32, and to the centre of Hill St., so-called, 511.94 ft.; thence South, and parallel to the E. line of section 32, 204 ft.; thence North-easterly by a line making an included angle of 83° 04' with the line last described, 332.2 ft.; thence North-easterly by a line making an included angle of 149° 53' 30" with the line just preceding, 165 ft., to the centre of Grove St.; thence South-easterly, at right angles, along the centre of Grove St., 354.3 ft., to the point of beginning, on the E. line of section 32, at the intersection of State and Grove Sts.

I hereby certify that the plat hereon delineated is a correct one, and that permanent monuments consisting of iron pipe surrounded by stones have been planted at points marked thus O as thereon shown at all angles in the boundaries of the land platted and at all intersections of streets or streets and alleys.
