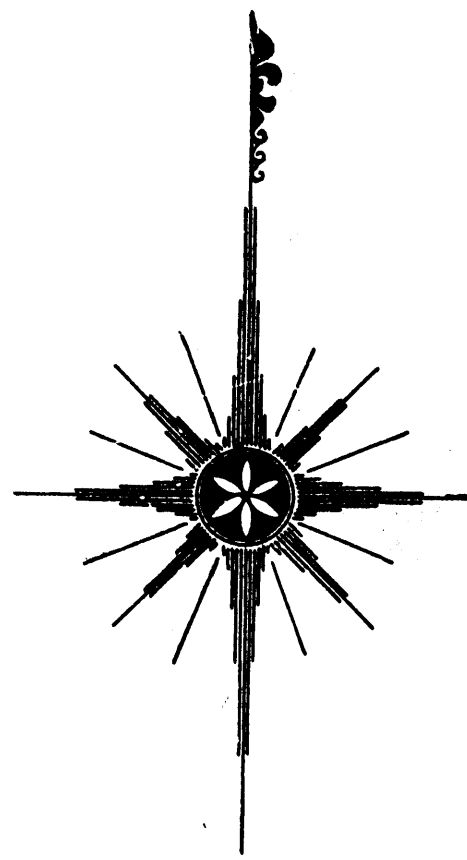
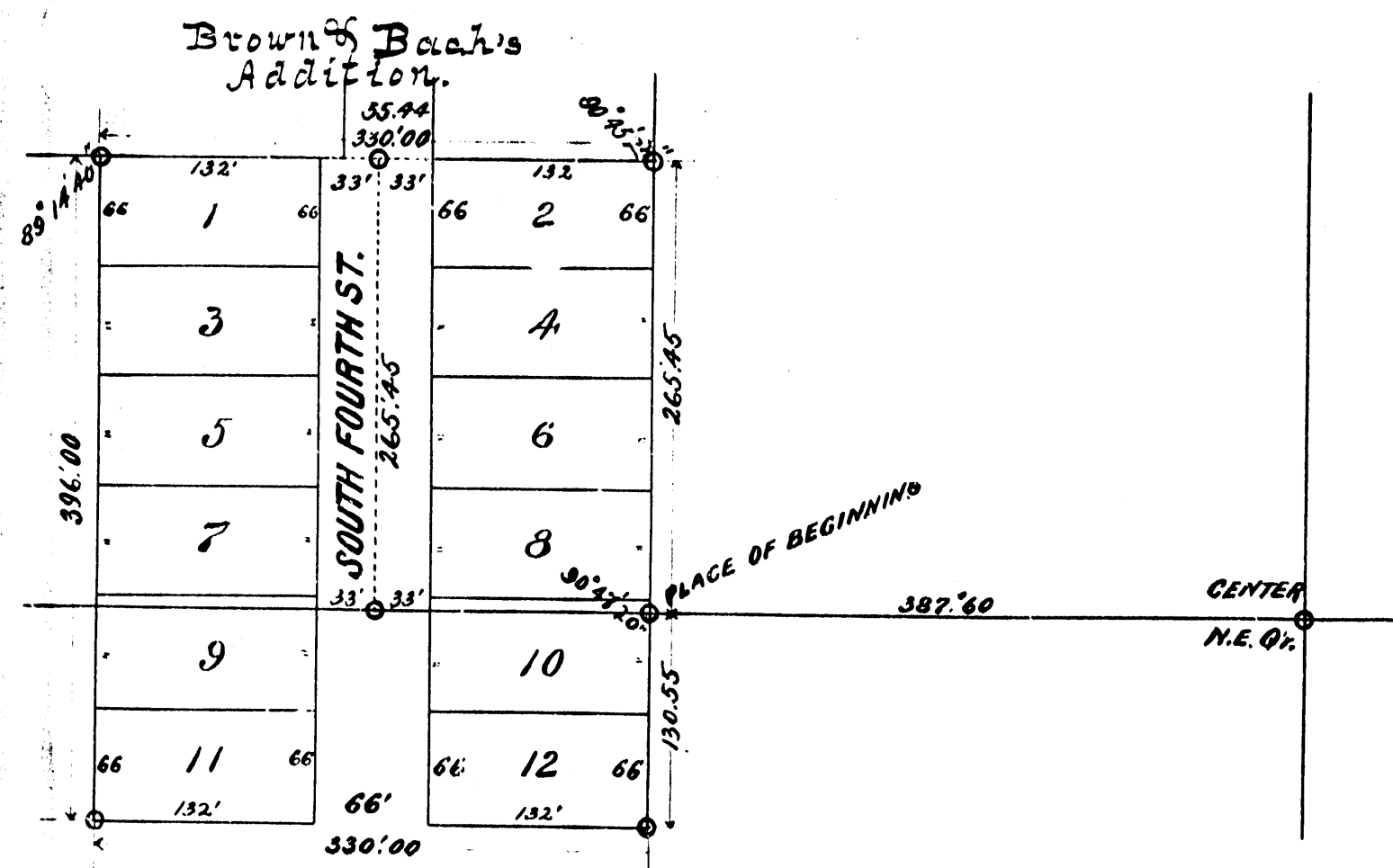


# MISS ELISABETH ALLMENDINGER'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ANN ARBOR MICHIGAN.

### DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLATTED.

Beginning at a point on the east and west half quarter line of the north east quarter of section thirty two (22) of township two (2) south of range six (6) east, Meridian of Michigan, three hundred and eighty seven and two tenths (387.40) feet west of 1/4th center of said quarter section; thence northerly deflecting  $90^{\circ} 47' 20''$  to the right, three hundred and forty four and forty four hundredths (344.44) feet to the north east corner of Brown and Bach's Addition; thence westerly deflecting  $90^{\circ} 45' 20''$  to the left, three hundred and thirty (330) feet along the south line of said addition; thence southerly deflecting  $87^{\circ} 14' 40''$  to the left, three hundred and ninety six (396) feet; thence easterly parallel to the south line of Brown and Bach's Addition three hundred and thirty (330) feet; thence northerly on the line of the course leaving the place of beginning, one hundred and thirty and fifty four hundredths (130.54) feet to the place of beginning, the same being a parallelogram three hundred and ninety six (396) feet long northerly and southerly by three hundred and thirty (330) feet wide, containing about three (3) acres of land.

### EXPLANATIONS.

Monuments of iron, stone and brick at the corners marked  $\circ$  set marked by white oak stakes two inches square and two feet long. Numbers on plat.
