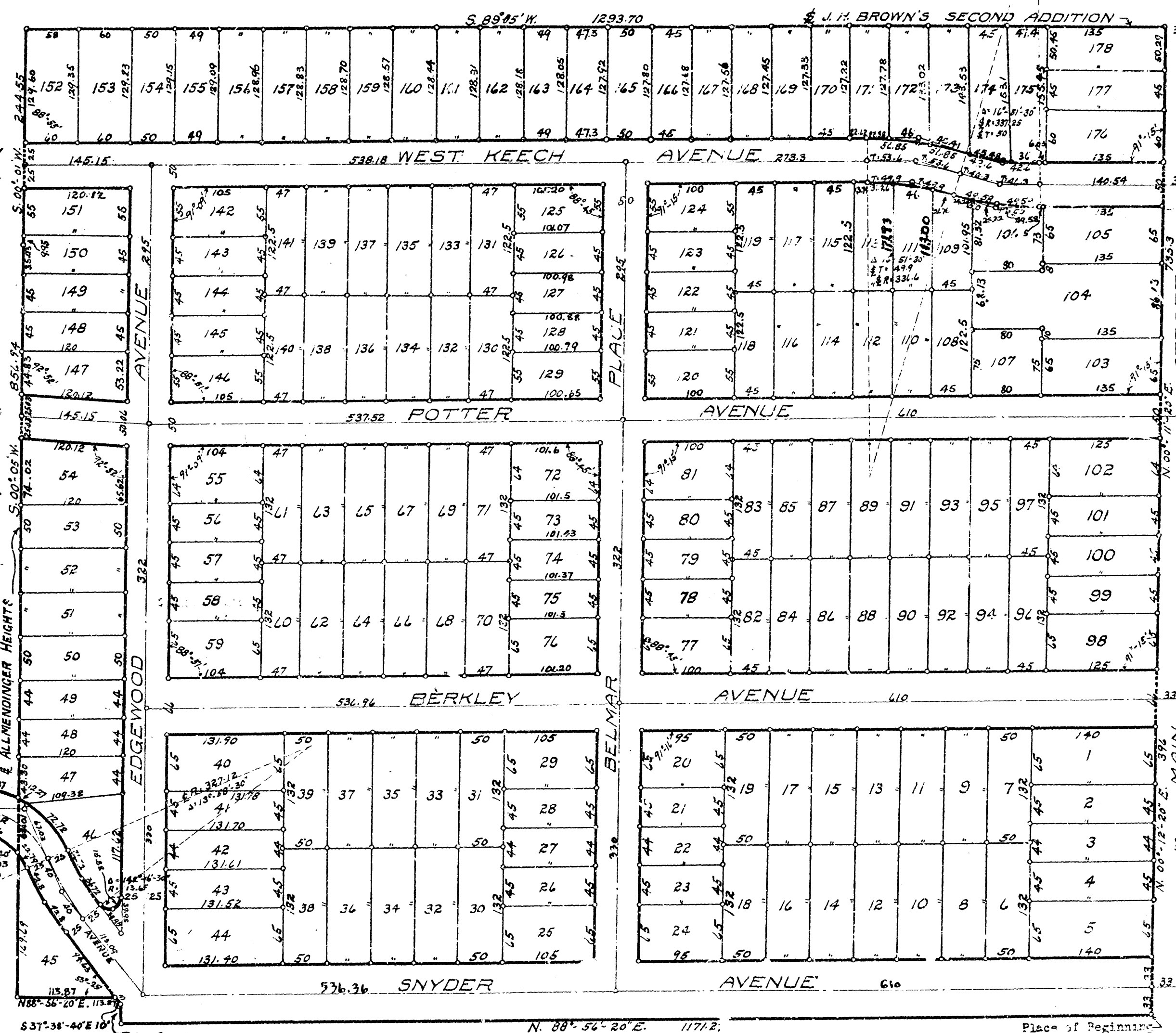

DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of "OAK CREST", a subdivision of a part of the northwest quarter, section 32, town two south, range six east, in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows: Commencing at a point in the west line of Main Street 198 feet north of the east and west quarter line of section 32 and 33 feet west of the north and south quarter line of section 32, town two south, range six east, in the City of Ann Arbor, Washtenaw County, Michigan; thence North 00 degrees 12 minutes and 20 seconds east along the west line of Main Street 396 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing along the west line of Main Street North 00 degrees, 11 minutes, and 20 seconds east 735.3 feet to an iron pipe at the intersection of the south line of J. H. Brown's Second Addition to the City of Ann Arbor and the west line of Main Street; thence south 89 degrees and 5 minutes west along said south line of J. H. Brown's Second Addition 1293.70 feet to an iron pipe in the east line of Allmendinger Heights; thence south 00 degrees and 1 minute west along the east line of Allmendinger Heights 244.55 feet to an iron pipe; thence continuing along said east line of Allmendinger Heights south 00 degrees 5 minutes west 856.74 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 88 degrees, 56 minutes, and 20 seconds east 113.20 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 37 degrees, 20 minutes, and 40 seconds east 10 feet to an iron pipe; thence south 00 degrees 5 minutes west 24.89 feet to an iron pipe; thence north 28 degrees, 56 minutes and 20 seconds east 1171.27 feet to the place of beginning.
