

Description:

R. S. Smith's Third Addition to the City of Ann Arbor is situated on the E 1/2 of W 1/2 of Section 28, Town 2 South of Range 6 East of the Principal Meridian, and bounded as follows: -

1st Starting at a point on the North line of Washtenaw Avenue, thirty links (30) E of E line of W 1/2 of W 1/2 Section 28, thence N 74° 10' W three chains and thirty eight (338) links; thence W. Thirty (30) links to the last mentioned line, thence N 1 1/4° W along said line to the S. line of Huron Street produced East;

2nd Thence along the S. line of Huron Street produced N 88° 47' E. to the W. line of Observatory Street;

3rd Thence S. along the W. line of Observatory Street to the North line of Cemetery Street;

4th Thence Westward along the North line of Cemetery Street to the North line of Washtenaw Avenue (excepting a row of lots on the North side of Cemetery Street numbered from 76 to 87 inclusive, as platted in R. S. Smith's First Addition to Ann Arbor City) thence South westerly along the N. line of Washtenaw Avenue to the place of starting. We do not hold ourselves responsible for any variation in the measurements.
