

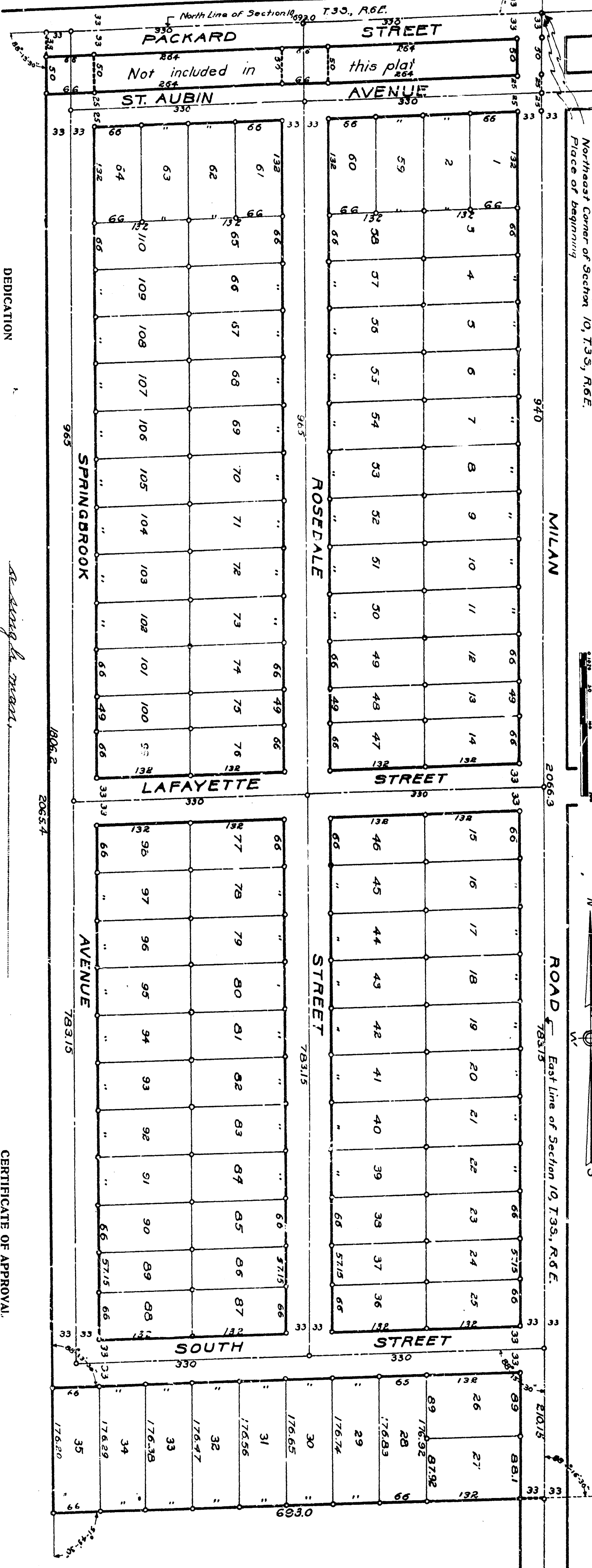
# ORIGINAL PLAT OF "SPRINGWATER SUBDIVISION NO. 1"

### DESCRIPTION

The land embraced in the annexed plat of Springwater Subdivision No. 1 on the east one-half of the north-east one quarter of section ten, Pittsfield Township, Washtenaw County, Michigan, is described as follows: commencing at the northeast corner of section ten, town three south, range six east, Meridian of Michigan; thence westerly along the north line of said section 693.0 feet; thence southerly, deflecting 88°-13'-30" to the left 2065.4 feet; thence easterly, deflecting 91°-43'-30" to the left 693.0 feet; thence northerly along east line of section 10, deflecting 16°-30" to the left 2066.3 feet to the place of beginning; excepting a parcel of land 650 feet in length east and west; and 50 feet in width bounded east by the west line of Milan Road and north by the south line of Richard Street.
