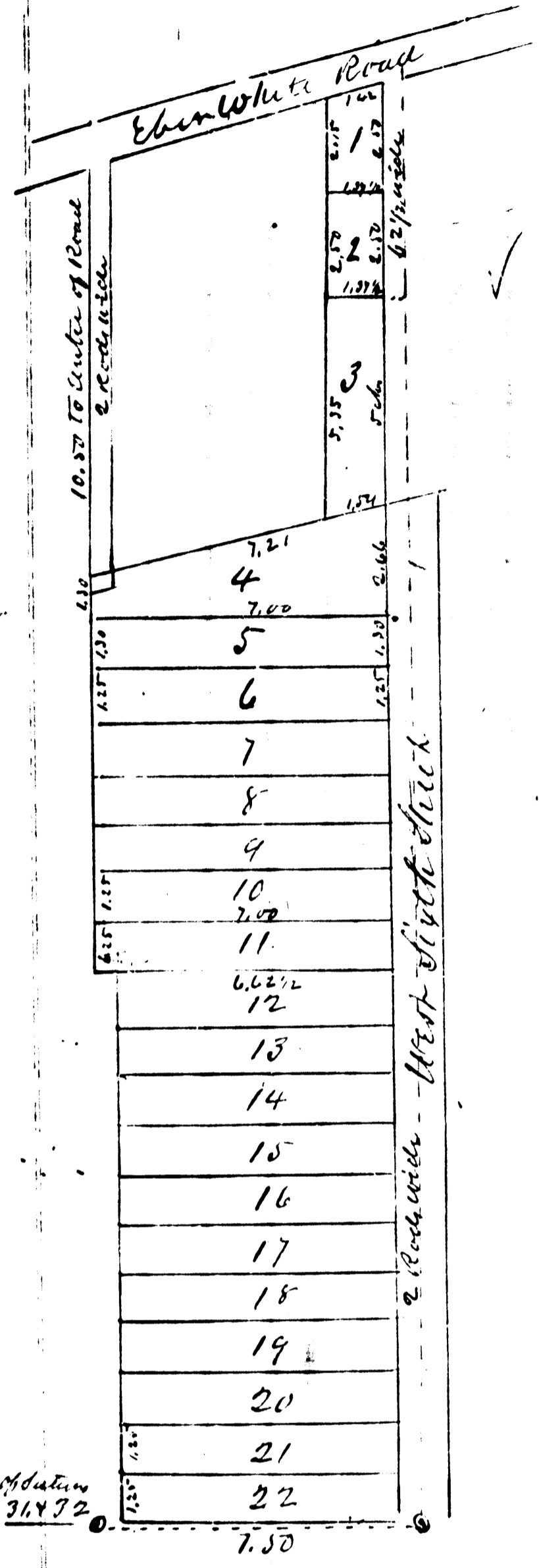


*Thompson, Spoor & Thompsons Addition
To the City of Ann Arbor*



Registered Office Washburn Co. p. Rec'd & Recorded this 11th day of April, A.D. 1861. at 2 1/2 o'clock P.M. in Liber No. 48 of Deeds page 83 - J. R. McLean, Regr. J. M. Ladd, Dep.

This addition to the City of Ann Arbor is situated on the west part of the west half of the south west quarter of Section twenty nine, of Township Two South of Range Six East, extending from the Eberwhite Road, to within 17 links of the line between sections 29 and 32. The length of lines being the length and width of lots are given in Reap chains and links in small figures. The numbers of the lots are given in large figures near the center of the lots thus 1, 2, 3.

That part of the street on the East side appropriated by the proprietor is 112 1/2 links wide from the Eberwhite Road to the South East corner of Lot No. 2. The west bounds then runs to the north East corner of Lot No. 4, when it is 50 links or 2 rods wide then continuing the same width to the South East of the plat

Thompson, do hereby assent to the said plat and remit and release all our right to Down of us, and to the streets, highways, or public grounds laid down and dedicated therein.
