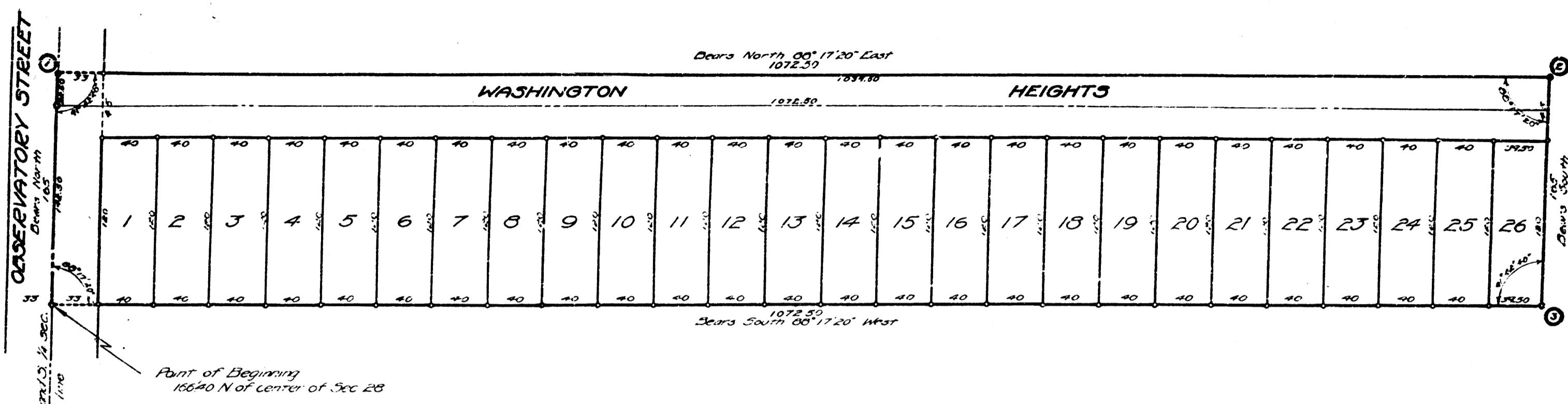

DESCRIPTION:

The land hereon platted as "WASHINGTON HEIGHTS ADDITION" to the City of Ann Arbor, is described as follows: commencing at a point on the north and south one-quarter line (center of Observatory Street) of section 28 which is one hundred sixty-six and forty one-hundredths (166.40) feet north of the center of said section; thence north along the north and south one-quarter line one hundred sixty-five (165.00) feet to a point (1); thence north eighty-eight degrees seventeen minutes and twenty seconds east one thousand and seventy-two and fifty one-hundredths (1072.50) feet to a point (2); thence south to the aforesaid north and south one-quarter line one hundred sixty-five (165.00) feet to a point (3); thence south eighty-eight degrees seventeen minutes and twenty seconds west one thousand and seventy-two and fifty one-hundredths (1072.50) feet to the place of beginning; being a part of the northeast one-quarter of Section twenty-eight (28), Town 2 South, Range 6 east, Ann Arbor City, Washtenaw County, Michigan.
