

Dedication.

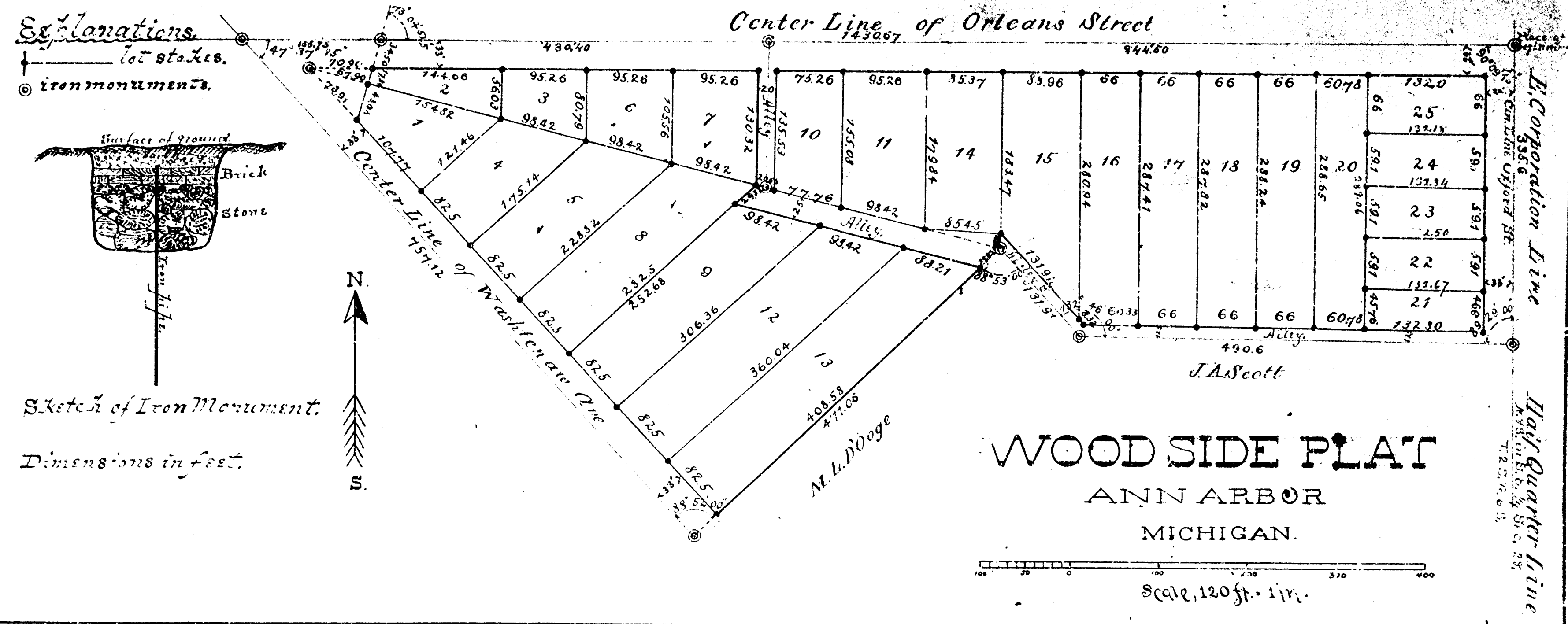

Description of Land Platted.

The land hereinafter described is the original plat of the Woodside Plat, Ann Arbor, Michigan, is described as follows: Beginning at an iron monument at the intersection of the center line of Orleans Street in said City with the East Boundary of the West Part of the East Quarter of Section Twenty-eight of Township Two South of Range Six East, Michigan; thence South along the said East Boundary, Three Hundred and Thirty-six and Six Tenths (336.6) feet to an iron monument; thence westerly, deflecting 90° 00' to the right along the north boundary of Austin Scott's land, Four Hundred and Ninety and Six Tenths (495.6) feet to an iron monument; thence north westerly deflecting 47° 14' 00" to the right along the north east boundary of M. L. Dodge's land One Hundred and Thirty-one and Ninety-one One Hundredths (131.91) feet to an iron monument; thence south westerly deflecting 91° 07' 00" to the left along the north west boundary of M. L. Dodge's land, Four Hundred and Seventy-one and Six One Hundredths (471.06) feet to an iron monument in the center of Washtenaw Avenue; thence north westerly deflecting 71° 08' 00" to the right along the center line of Washtenaw Avenue, Seven Hundred and Fifty-seven and Twelve One Hundredths (757.12) feet to an iron monument at the intersection of the center lines of Washtenaw Avenue and Orleans Street; thence easterly deflecting 132° 22' 45" to the right along the center line of Orleans Street Fourteen Hundred and Thirty and Sixty-seven One Hundredths (1430.67) feet to the place of beginning.
